Scottish company Endura must get its fair share of mixed weather around its Edinburgh HQ, so I was expecting some good things from the Windchill gloves. For the middle of the road price, there's a decent amount of insulation and the windproofing kept my hands warm down into single figures. However,

'water-resistant' may be pushing it — these gloves gathered in water pretty quickly, and held it there even when the rain had stopped.

The black area you see on the Endura
Windchill gloves around the wrist is quite firm
and inflexible, which means that they don't
stuff down as small as some of the other
gloves — a problem if the temperature starts
to rise a couple of hours into your weekend
ride and you want to stuff them away in your
pockets. They are very comfortable,
though, with the gel padding soaking
up road buzz, a useful feature on
long rides on rougher roads.
