↘ When the autumnal temperatures take a dip into single figures, it's time to reach for the Windchill – and not a moment before. With a thicker fleece backing on a windproof front and sleeves, you'd struggle to wear this above 10°C and not cook in your own juices. But when you really need it, you'll be very glad it's there.

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Thanks to the stretchy Roubaix fabric on the sides and rear, everything is pulled in nicely for a good fit while at the same time improving the moisture removal from the inside. A snug neck and brushed interior make you

feel 'cherished' in a very 21st Century way (because we're worth it) while the softshell does a grand job of beating off the wet and cold.

With the back exposed to strong winds you can get a bit cold thanks to the non-windproof material there, but we found this rare and only when hanging around too long in a hilltop gale. Turn into the wind and you're protected.

For the money you really can't go wrong and, if you plan to ride through the properly cold winter months, this jacket is highly recommended.
