Endura's Windchill II combines thermal Roubaix fabric under the arms, on the side and on the back and waterproof panelling on the front and sleeves. Together that results in a pretty versatile jacket, and it's one of the best on test when it comes to stopping both wind and rain. Zipped under-arm vents also allow for a bit of temperature regulation. Storage is handled by three rear pockets and one small zipped pocket, plus there's a concealed compartment on the front complete with glasses wipe, which can come in pretty handy. There's a laser-cut inner storm flap at the back - always a nice touch when the rain comes down - which is effective at keeping your shorts chamois dry and comfy. Fit-wise, the Endura came up larger for a medium than any of the other jackets on test here, so we recommend trying one on before you buy if possible. But overall it's a very proficient, warm winter jacket coupled with decent rain protection at an excellent price.
