



## Endura MTR II £82.99

Endura's lightweight four-way stretch fabric is among the most comfortable on test – soft to the touch and unobtrusive, plus DWR-coated at the back to ward off wheel spray. Comfort is further enhanced by the large, well-ventilated stretch panel at the rear, which allows the MTR IIs to hug your back. Rubber grippers inside the waistband keep the shorts firmly in place. The fit is athletic – figure-hugging around the waist without being restrictive, with legs that taper outwards slightly to accommodate pads. A double popper and metal clasp mean the adjustable waistband feels super-secure. The shorts' relatively high price is backed up by excellent attention to detail – the leg hem is imperceptible

and the seamless panel around the crotch is particularly large. Two zipped side pockets are provided, plus one at the rear, although they're not perfect shapes. The fairly large side pockets mean items sit towards your inner thigh, which isn't as comfy as on other shorts, and the rear pocket is far too small to fit a phone. We were pleased to see the pocket zips are of the chunkier plastic style, which in our experience tend to last longer than the finer sealed zips. The MTRs are also 'Clickfast' compatible, so you can couple them with Endura liners if those are your preferred pad.
