


# ENDURA URBAN JERSEY \$90

I'm a big fan of wool cycling apparel, especially when it looks at home off the bike as much as it does on. Endura's Urban Coolmax Merino Long Sleeve Jersey checks both those boxes. Made with a Coolmax/Merino blend it is slightly stretchy and form fitting so it'll show off your toned cycling physique ...or those extra pounds you are lugging around from a few too many slices of pizza. 

Wool is well-known as a great insulator, even when wet. Pair that with Coolmax, a fabric designed to wick moisture away from the wearer's body, and you've got a jersey that will keep you dry and warm.

The jersey comes in a cycling specific cut, meaning a slim fit and a slightly longer back to cover your crack while cycling. After you've warmed up pedaling around a bit you can easily vent by unsnapping the V-neck which runs about halfway down the chest. There's also a decently sized pocket on the back left which is accessible through a nicely hidden zipper. I found it perfect for securely stashing some cash, keys and phone for after my ride.

This isn't a very heavy wool jersey, so you'll need to layer a bit in particularly cold weather, but because of the weight it transitions nicely from biking to enjoying an evening with friends at the local gallery opening. I like when products work well and look great, both on and off the bike. Endura has a winner here.
